

"Visit to District Jail, Old Age Home by Sociology Students of A.V.K. Mahila College"

Sociology students of B.A degree classes visited Chaitanya Vruddhashram, Gavenahalli Bypass Road, Hassan on Date: 03.06.2023 for field study related to syllabus and collected information from elderly people. Under the influence of modernity, the precious human values of the joint family like unity, cooperation, harmony, kindness, compassion, tolerance and virtues are decaying and the life of the elderly is becoming miserable day by day.

Social transformation has led to the increase of nuclear families, making life difficult for the destitute, widows, widowers, mentally challenged, divorced, homeless, deaf and dumb children. As a shelter for the lives of such neglected people, Chaitanya Vruddhashram is functioning as a model institution with the financial support of the Government.

He consoled the dear friend with words of love and compassion for the elderly in the shelter. Devotional song, lyrical song, patriotic song, entertained and distributed sweets. 10 children between 1 to 06 months, 18 elderly men, 29 elderly women, 09 cattle, 02 calves - the organization's loving care and nurturing has given the elderly a sigh of relief. This institution is a model for the society.
